## Hyperlinks

Hyperlinks are navigational tools that allow you to easily access information in other locations within an existing or new document. Documents can contain hyperlinked text or image.

### Hyperlinked Text

All **blue** text are hyperlinked. Some **blue** text represent Acts in the “Table of Contents” and the “List of Chapters and Titles” are hyperlinked items (see Figures 1 and 2 below).

To access an Act click on the **blue** text. This will take you to the document.


