Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Notification of Absence Act.

Interpretation.

2. In this Act, “officer” means any person appointed by the Governor-General, Prime Minister, or a Minister to be,

(a) a member of any committee or board;

(b) a commissioner of any kind; or

(c) a visiting justice of any prison.

Officer leaving
Belize to give
notice in writing.

3. Every officer intending to go beyond the limits of Belize shall give written notice of such intention to the Governor-General, the Prime Minister or Minister, as the case may be.
