- Short title. **1.** This Act may be cited as the Belize Scholarship Act.
- Interpretation. **2.** In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires, “Minister” means the Minister responsible for Education.
- Establishing of
Scholarship. **3.** There shall be established a Scholarship to be known as the Belize Scholarship, hereinafter called “the Scholarship”.
- To be competed for
in alternate years. **4.** The Scholarship shall be open to competition in the year 1944 and in every year thereafter.
- Defraying of costs. **5.** The cost of each Scholarship shall be defrayed from the Consolidated Revenue Fund.
- Regulations.
40 of 1963. **6.**—(1) The Minister may by regulation prescribe the conditions of award, tenure and forfeiture of the Scholarship and the conditions to be observed by a person to whom the Scholarship is awarded.

 (2) Regulations made under this section shall be subject to negative resolution.
